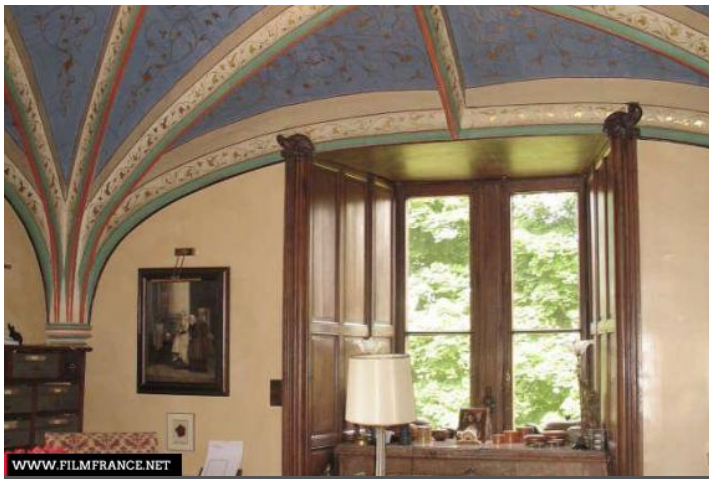

Built in the fourteenth and the fifteenth century, Vernay's castle was owned by Mathurin of Vernay, seneschal of Amaury de Craon in 1312. He served as a refuge during the unrest years of Angevine Vendée revolted.
